

ACCESSIBLE VEHICLE GRANT OPEN

The Gateway Chapter is now opening its annual grant for accessible vehicle funding. There are three different grant levels:

\$35,000 - member does not currently own any accessible vehicle

\$17,500 - for a member to purchase a non accessible vehicle with knowledge that hand controls will be purchased

\$10,000 - member currently has an accessible vehicle that needs updates OR member has vehicle to trade-in, in addition to the Gateway funding for a newer accessible vehicle.

If you have interest in this grant, please complete the Accessible Vehicle Grant Application that can be found on our website www.gatewaypva. org under the "Forms" tab. You can email the application to the office at chris@gatewaypva.org or amber@gatewaypva.org, or send it to our office.

This application form helps explain your need for the vehicle and what difference the grant would make in your life. Entries must be received by Wednesday, May 31, 2023.

As in the past, the Board will not grade or rank the entries, but rather put all qualified requests "in the hat" and randomly draw names for the winners at the June Board of Directors meeting.








REPORT OF SENIOR NATIONAL SERVICE OFFICER

Spinal Cord Injury Parking Signs



As you may be aware the parking area in the Kansas City, MO VAMC for veterans with Spinal Cord Injury and Dysfunction (SCI/D) in the parking lot by the Patriot Store and Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation (PM&R) does not exist anymore. The new parking spots are located across from the Freedom Tower Entrance. There are four spots and you will need a Red Placard like before. If you don't have one then you can get one from Ann Culver, SCI/D Nurse in PM&R or Carrie Duncan, Neurology Nurse. Please display the Red Placard when you park in those spots. If you see a vehicle that does not have a Red Placard please report it to the VA Police. Some people still mistake them for regular handicapped spots and they are strictly 24 hour parking spots for veterans with SCI/D.

Also, please let your local National Service Officer know if you are having any issues with your VA Medical Care. For the past few years it appears that the spinal cord clinic has migrated to veterans with SCI/D have a regular Primary Care Doctor. I want to advise that if you have any concerns related to your SCI/D then to contact your Specialty Clinic, such as, the Spinal Cord Clinic Nurse or Social Worker or Neurology Nurse to address any specialty needs.



OFFICERS

PRESIDENT-

3 year term

The President is the principal executive officer of the Chapter. The duties of the Chapter President are:



Who is at the Chapter Board meetings?

The Chapter Officers and Directors.

Can members that are not on the Board attend?

YES! All Gateway members are welcome to attend Board meetings, with the exception of any Executive Sessions of the meeting. The Chapter encourages members to attend meetings so that they may stay up to speed on the activities of the Chapter throughout the year.

Do I earn Sports Points for attending?

YES! Whether you attend in person or via Zoom, members earn 15 Sports Points for sitting in.

What happens at these meetings?

General business is conducted at these meetings, such as approving Chapter grants, voting on expenditures, amending policies, or voting on donation requests.

Am I able to vote on anything?

Only Chapter Officers and Board of Directors may vote on matters during these meetings. If any Gateway member would like to become involved on the Chapter Board, you may nominate yourself for the ballot at each fiscal year end, for the following fiscal year (July 1 to June 30). For example, at the end of Fiscal Year 2023, we sent out a notice via the Gateway Gazette (March/April issue) asking for nominations so that we may present them in the Gateway Gazette in the May/June issue on the enclosed ballot.

When are the Chapter Board meetings?

Unless otherwise rescheduled, meetings happen on the second Tuesday of each month at 11:30am.

Where are the Chapter Board meetings?

Meetings are held at the Gateway Chapter office, but members may also join on Zoom after contacting Amber via email for the meeting Zoom link.

Are there any rules I should know about?

Overall there are not specific rules to follow, but we do ask that you are courteous to the Board while they are conducting business during meetings. Please silence your phones, do not have any side conversations while they are discussing matters, and in general please do not interrupt. Our VA SCI/D OTs cover so much more beyond ADLs- including Assistive Technology; Home adaptations/ equipment/ access; Transportation management and community access; VA and community grant resource education/ consultation- just to name a few! Occupational Therapy covers a lot of ground in VA SCI/D healthcare! Our OT staff has really expanded their presence with our SCI Outpatient Clinic and SCI Home Care team. This presence beyond the inpatient rehabilitation clinic is essential to support our lifelong health and wellness goals for veterans with SCI/D.




