# **ANNOUNCEMENTS**

#### MEMBERSHIP GRANT CHANGES

There have been a few amendments to the Chapter member grant program that members need to be aware of. If you have any questions about these changes listed below, feel free to contact the office and speak with Executive Director Chris Blanchard or Executive Assistant Amber Lee.

The first amendment is that the Board has capped monthly expenses on membership grants (Home Accessibility and Hand Controls) to \$20,000. This decision was made to keep the Chapter fiscally responsible.

How this amendment effects Chapter members:

All bids that are received will be presented to the Board at the monthly meeting.

If all the approved bids total below \$20,000; all membership grants will be awarded that month

If all the approved bids total above \$20,000; the Board then discusses which grants will be awarded that month and the remainder grants will be awarded the following month.

The second amendment is that once a membership grant is approved, a member must use this grant within 12 months of the approval. This amendment applies to all membership grants; Home Accessibility, Hand Controls, Generator, and Accessible Vehicle.

As a reminder, the Home Accessibility and Hand Control grants are the only grants that are available all year long. The Generator and the Accessible Vehicle grants are only available once a year. Announcements of their openings will be on our social media, emailed, and in this newsletter (Generator grant opening seen in Executive Assistant article on page 4).

#### **GENERATOR GRANT**

The Gateway Chapter membership Generator grant will be open from October 1 2023 to November 1, 2023 for the amount of \$5,500.

This grant can be applied to a portable generator (which should cost less than the \$5500) or go toward an automatic permanent home generator (which will cost more than that grant amount). In either case, portable or permanent home generator, members are required to obtain two bids for the same product or scope of work. If the cost of work exceeds \$5500, the member is responsible for the remaining amount. Photos of work before and after must be submitted to the Chapter by either the member or the vendor. Lien waivers must also be submitted to the Chapter. Once the grant has been approved, the approved grant amount must be completed within twelve (12) months.


